# Rule History Title 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 115 Degreasing Processes

#### Introduction

The official version of the rules in <u>Chapter 115, Subchapter E, Division 1</u> is available on the Secretary of State's website.

Each revision is identified by the date the commission adopted the changes. When available, the rule project number, which is the unique identification number from the rules tracking database for the specific rule project, is also provided for reference.

The *Texas Register* publications of the rule proposal and adoption are given for each revision. The proposed rules are approved by the commissioners to be published in the *Texas Register* for public comment. Once adopted by the commissioners, the rules are republished as final in the *Texas Register*.

These rules are submitted for United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approval as part of the State Implementation Plan (SIP) control strategy to meet the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for ozone. Links to the *Federal Register* publication of the EPA's approval of these rules and the associated SIP revisions are also included.

The summary information includes the affected sections of the rule, the counties affected, the compliance date, and a brief description of the rule revisions. If the adopted rule does not provide for additional time to comply with any new or revised requirements then compliance with any rule revisions is required by the effective date of the rulemaking.

#### Summary:

The rulemaking requires the owner or operator of degreasing processes in Wise County to comply with the same rules that currently apply in the other nine DFW counties. The rulemaking reformats the division by creating a new "Applicability and Definitions" section and "Exemptions" section.

The rulemaking adds recordkeeping requirement necessary to demonstrate compliance with the existing rule requirements and establishes a compliance date for processes in the DFW area that become subject to the rules on or after the compliance date. The rulemaking also makes other nonsubstantive changes.

The rulemaking is necessary to satisfy federal reasonably available control technology (RACT) requirements for Wise County as a result of the DFW nonattainment area's expansion under the 2008 eight-hour ozone NAAQS. This rulemaking is part of the DFW 2008 Eight-Hour Ozone Nonattainment Area Attainment Demonstration SIP Revision (2013-015-SIP-NR) (06/03/2015).

#### Summary:

The rulemaking requires acetone solvents used in the fiber-reinforced plastics and cultured marble industries be replaced with low vapor pressure VOC solvents or water-based solvents. ## Summary:

The rulemaking extends controls to degreasing processes located in the counties recently designated as nonattainment (Collin, Chambers, Denton, Fort Bend, Hardin, Liberty, Montgomery, and Waller Counties) and ensures the controls in all nonattainment counties are the same level of stringency.

The rulemaking lowers the exemption threshold to 15 pounds of VOC per day in Brazoria, Galveston, Jefferson, and Orange Counties.

The rulemaking also moves the existing requirements for sources in Gregg, Nueces, and Victoria Counties to a separate subsection in each section, but does not impose any new requirements on sources in these three counties.

The rulemaking is necessary to ensure all nonattainment counties are subject to the same level of control to satisfy federal RACT requirements and is part of the  $\underline{15\% \text{ ROP}}$  SIP Revision (Phase I) (11/10/1993).

### Summary:

The rulemaking adds equipment specifications and operating parameters to the control requirements for cold solvent, open top vapor, and conveyorized degreasing processes. The rulemaking lowers the exemption threshold for degreasing processes located in Harris County from 100 pounds to 3 pounds per 24-hour period, and exempts degreasing sources in Ector County from the majority of the new requirements adopted in this rulemaking.

#### Summary:

The rulemaking establishes rules for cold solvent, open top vapor, and conveyorized degreasing processes in the affected counties. The rules specify work practices and operating parameters for degreasing processes that emit at least 100 pounds of VOC per 24-hour period in Harris County and at least 550 pounds of VOC per 24-hour period in all other affected counties.

The adopted rulemaking implements RACT requirements for degreasing processes based on the EPA's 1977 *Control of Volatile Organic Emissions from Solvent Metal Cleaning* control techniques guidelines document (EPA-450/2-77-022).
